Kidder Mathews is pleased to present a rare opportunity to lease the historic Mayan Theater, a landmark entertainment venue in the heart of Downtown LA.

This ±20,741 SF property sits on a ±14,400 SF lot (0.33 acres) and stands as an extraordinary example of Mayan Revival architecture. Originally built in 1927 and designated LA Historic-Cultural Monument No. 460, the venue is zoned for restaurant, bar, and food service use. The Mayan Theater is a fully operational nightclub and live event space with professional-grade infrastructure, including a 40' x 13' stage, dance floor, balcony seating, and dressing rooms.

A Type 48 ABC license (on-sale general for bars and nightclubs) may be available for purchase. This grandfathered full liquor license allows alcohol sales without a food service requirement. Due to geographic restrictions and limited supply under current ABC guidelines, this license represents a unique opportunity for qualified operators.

Located within walking distance of Crypto.com Arena, LA Live, and the Convention Center—with a Walk Score of 98—the property is ideally positioned to benefit from high foot traffic, excellent transit access, and proximity to major entertainment destinations.




SITUATED IN A DENSE URBAN LOCATION WITH CONVENIENT ACCESSIBILITY



VIBRANT URBAN CULTURAL HUB

The Mayan Theater is located in Downtown Los Angeles' Broadway Theater District, a vibrant area known for its rich concentration of historic theaters, live music venues, and nightlife spots. This designated Historic Cultural Monument district features stunning early 20th-century architecture and contributes to LA's dynamic arts and entertainment scene, making the Mayan a true cultural and architectural gem in the city's urban fabric.

ENTERTAINMENT & NIGHTLIFE EPICENTER

Surrounded by a dense mix of over 100+ bars, restaurants, theaters, and cultural venues within a one-mile radius, Downtown LA offers an unparalleled

entertainment ecosystem. The Mayan Theater benefits from proximity to iconic venues such as the Belasco Theatre, the Orpheum, and LA's emerging rooftop and lounge scenes, drawing locals and tourists alike.

CONVENTION & TOURISM POWERHOUSE

Downtown LA is home to the Los Angeles Convention Center, which hosts over 700 events annually and attracts millions of visitors. The nearby Crypto.com Arena (formerly Staples Center) hosts major sports teams including the LA Lakers, Clippers, and Kings, as well as top-tier concerts and events with average attendances in the tens of thousands. This proximity provides a continuous flow of foot traffic and event-driven patronage.

PRIME ACCOMMODATION ACCESS

With over 20,000 hotel rooms in the Downtown LA area—including luxury brands and boutique hotels—visitors and business travelers enjoy easy access to the Mayan Theater and its vibrant surroundings.

A GLOBAL DESTINATION

Los Angeles welcomed approximately 50 million visitors in 2023, making it one of the world's top tourist destinations. Leisure travelers account for the majority, drawn to LA's beaches, entertainment industry attractions, cultural institutions, and year-round mild climate. The Mayan Theater's location provides seamless connectivity to these attractions via extensive public transit options and walkable streets.
